#### **General**

### 1. Quality Services

The Council provides a number of services to the local population. It will seek to ensure that these services meet the needs of the local population and that they represent value for money. The Council welcomes the involvement of residents in its decision making process and will consult residents on issues of importance.

# 2. Encourage Partnership/Sponsorship Approach and Funding

The Parish Council is one of many organisations working within the Community. We should encourage investment of both time and resources by other agencies to help achieve our objectives. We should join forces with County and District Councils and with the business community, voluntary bodies and local residents associations for the benefit of the community.

#### 3. Winsham Traffic Speed

The Parish Council wishes to improve the speeding levels within the Parish. To this end Speed Indicator Devices (SIDs) will be installed at the entrance to the village on various occasions throughout the year.
