PUBLIC FORUM

A speaker in the Public Forum may only represent his or her point of view, and may not claim to speak for other residents unless they are also present at the Forum and clearly affirm that they are prepared to allow the speaker to express their point of view for them. After the statement those involved should be asked to affirm that what was said represented their viewpoint. The Chair of the meeting has absolute discretion to request the speaker to stop, or adjourn the Public Forum at any time.

Criticism of Parish Council action or lack of action is acceptable, but serious complaints relating to alleged malfeasance or malpractice must be made using the proper complaints procedure. This is to protect the complainant and the Parish Council, in the event of concerns proving to be unfounded.

No decision can be taken on issues raised unless the matter is already an item on the agenda. As this is not part of the formal meeting minutes will not be produced.
